

- o Welcome to the Blue Ridge Region – SCCA autocross.
  - .. All first time autocrossers should come to the front.
- o Register via the Internet at [www.BRR-SCCA.org](http://www.BRR-SCCA.org)... guaranteed event entry... no penalty for no show.  
COST... Preregistered SCCA member 25.00 / non-member 30.00      Walk up SCCA member 30.00 / non-member 35.00
- o Become an BRR-SCCA member – \$80.00 individual 100.00 family 45.00 FirsGear (under 24 year old). \$15.00 credit for referral-both.
  - .. SportsCar magazine / Additional insurance coverage at SCCA events.
  - .. SCCA member discounts on BRR-SCCA events and merchandise.
  - .. Yearly Tech inspection program for BRR-SCCA.
  - .. Permanent car number for the year for BRR-SCCA events.
  - .. Eligible for Year-end BRR-SCCA Awards.
- o Car Numbers and Class Designations on both sides of the car. 8” numbers 4” class.. paper provided at Registration. Print your own from the web site.
- o Everyone must sign the Insurance Waiver and display a wrist band – will be located at the registration table.
- o Speed Limit
  - .. Drive fast on the course NOT in the paddock or surrounding public roads...be a good Citizen... you represent BRR-SCCA.
  - .. Walking speed in the paddock.
  - .. NO burnouts or spinning of tires in the paddock area.. this is illegal as an SCCA event and will disqualify you.
  - .. Be good citizens so we may use the site again.
- o SAFETY is of the highest importance.
  - .. Solo Safety Steward has approved the site and will monitor the event for safety issues.
  - .. Car CONTROL event, keep your car under control at all times.
  - .. If you lose control of your car BOTH feet in, brake and clutch to the floor.
  - .. If you lose the course, please continue to the finish timing lights to trip the scoring computer.
  - .. Every driver and passenger MUST have a helmet and safety belt on before approaching the starting line.
  - .. NO hand held cameras in the car and all limbs must remain inside the vehicle.
  - .. DO NOT run over the timing lights.
  - .. Riders are permitted over the age of 12, must sign the waiver and wear a helmet... driver is responsible for the actions of the rider.
  - .. Any photographer on course must have a spotter and be approved by the Safety Steward.
- o RED Flag is displayed if there is an unsafe condition on the autocross course.
  - .. Keep RED flag unfurled and ready at all times, held by radio operator.
  - .. Workers should display the RED flag and call “RED FLAG” on the radio, on any condition they think is unsafe.
  - .. All worker stations should display the RED flag if one station has an unsafe condition.
  - .. If shown a RED flag as a driver, come to a controlled STOP, continue at a slow speed only after the corner worker releases you.
  - .. Radio, Fire extinguisher, and red flag at each worker station.
- o Cone rules and penalties will be demonstrated by the Cone Board.
  - .. Two second penalty if a cone is knocked over or out of the box.
  - .. Pointer cones do count as a penalty.
  - .. Not an off course for driving out side the white chalk lines, they are just a visual reference.. Off course if you miss a gate.
  - .. Call in cone penalties on the radio to scoring by give Car Number, Class and type of penalty.. number of cones / off course.
  - .. Driver must stop and point out a misplaced cone to receive a rerun.
- o Working - Volunteer organization so everyone must work a position to help the event run smoothly.
  - .. Each worker is responsible for their own safety.
  - .. Always stay alert and face the oncoming car, do NOT turn your back to the course or car.
  - .. Stay on your feet at all times.
  - .. If you do not preform your work assignment you will have to work 2 assignments before you will be allowed to run in another BRR-SCCA event.
  - .. No Cameras or electronic devices such as cell phones allowed on course while working.
- o RUN/WORK Groups
  - .. RUN by Class.. review Run /Work groups on marker board...choose your worker assignment
  - .. Introduce Worker Steward.
  - .. When your Work/Run group is called, first check with the Worker Steward, then take your position.  
Be PROMPT. Showing up late is the same as not working.
- o Have a FUN and SAFE event.
